

Fatmir Guri is an Associated Professor of Economics of natural resources and environment at Agricultural University of Tirana. He holds a PhD in Economics (land economics) from Supagro Montpellier France and continues to work in the Department of Economics and Rural Development Policies of the Faculty of Economics and Agribusiness.

His work and experience includes a post doctoral research period in the in house research institute of the European Commission i.e. Joint research Centre in Seville Spain. His research interests and publications focus on land economics and the evolution of land use

in Albania as well as the strategy of agricultural farms on the coastal area in Albania.

An important piece of research made by Mr. Guri, is focused on land de collectivisation process in Albania as well as the effects on farming systems' productivity. His research deals as well on the land prices and the factors that impact directly land price on the agricultural area, the impact of alternative land uses on land prices etc. Another field of research is linked with the productivity of farming systems and the farming systems typology in Albania. He is a member of different research network on farming systems and rural development on the Mediterranean areas (RAFAC), Foncimed – on land issues on Mediterranean areas, Modam etc.

He is board member of the Foundation "Assembly of the citizens of the Mediterranean areas". Since 2015 to present he has been a member of the Accreditation Board on Higher Education (former Council) of Albania.
